We know you have been following the news about the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and are taking all appropriate precautions. If you are running a fever or are experiencing any acute respiratory symptoms, such as a cough or shortness of breath, we encourage you to take care of yourself by staying home and seeking proper medical attention.

In order to prevent the spread of infection, the following measures have been taken:

All exam rooms, bathrooms, common areas, and all office areas are disinfected with EPA-registered disinfectants adhering to state & federal guidelines for disinfection in order to kill viral pathogens. Routine cleaning and disinfection procedures are carried out consistently between patient visits.

All staff have been properly instructed in how to wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds. Hands are always washed before and after contact with all patients.

An alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol is also available at the front desk, as well as gloves and face masks upon request.

High-touch surfaces such as tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, sinks, etc. are all thoroughly cleaned according to official guidelines and recommendations.

Lastly, Dr. Gabella has taken extra measures to see only one patient at a time, therefore, patients will never need to wait in the lobby with other people, thus reducing the risk of spread and contamination.
